## Veterans Day Parade Information

### Overview

The purpose of the parade is to honor the men and women, past and present, who have served in the military to protect the freedoms we now enjoy. Please create and organize your entry to show appreciation for our veterans.

### Staging

The parade will line up at 10:00 AM in the parking lot behind First Baptist Church on Main Street between 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> Street. **Participants must be in place no later than 10:45 AM.**

### Parade Route

The parade will start at 11:00 AM and enter the route from the First Baptist Church parking lot onto 13<sup>th</sup> Street and travel south to Center Street then west to 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Parade will then begin on Main Street and will proceed east, on Main Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street, turn left and return to staging.

### Safety

Throwing candy from parade float or vehicles is strictly prohibited. Adult riders may gently toss candy to spectators away from moving vehicles. Preferred way of distributing candy is to have someone walk along the sides of the float or vehicle (safely away from moving vehicles) to distribute candy to spectators.

### Lineup Position

You will be given a number upon arriving for staging on the morning of the parade when you check in on November 10. Your number will identify you to the announcer. You do not need to be in any particular order as long as the number is clearly visible.

### Application Deadline
