ITEM 3. Discussion of possible use of city property located at 823 W. Main Street, Collinsville, Oklahoma.

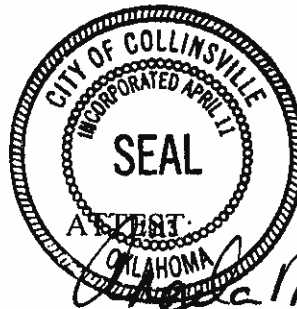

There has been some interest shown in renting the building already. According to Pam Polk City Manager there is no plan and no money in regards to the long-term use of the property.
