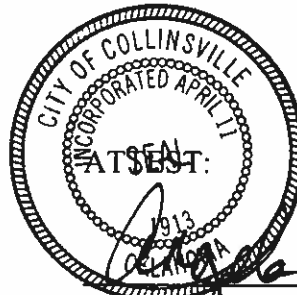
ITEM 7. Discussion on Frisbee Golf Course at Collinsville City Park.
